- ☐ Complete and pass OSAP-DALE Foundation Dental Infection Prevention and Control Certificate Program
 - ➤ Understanding CDC's Summary of Infection Prevention Practices in Dental Settings (2 CEs)
 - > OSAP-DALE Foundation Dental Infection Prevention and Control eHandbook (10 CEs)
- ☐ Accrue 100 CE Credits within five years of induction
 - > 50 CEs must be AADOM-approved CE hours
 - CE's must be obtained from AADOM's e-Campus or **DPLN** meetings
 - > 50 CEs may be AGD-PACE and/or ADA-CERP-approved
 - > 12 CEs are from completion of the OSAP-Dale program.

MAADOM MAINTENANCE

MAADOMs must renew annually to maintain their MAADOM designation. Annual maintenance includes:

- ☐ Accruing 15 AADOM-approved Continuing Education (CE) credits each calendar year. Seven of these credits can be from AGD/PACE and/or ADA/CERP approved
- $\hfill\square$ Maintaining good standing as an AADOM Member and following AADOM's Code of Conduct.
- ☐ Attending at least one AADOM Conference every three
- \square Pay a \$50 annual maintenance fee (or \$35 for lifetime members).
